 - Task list updated May 13, 2026 and circulated.

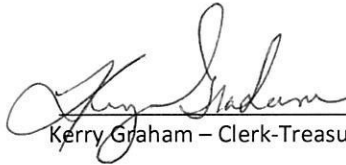
- 16) **Correspondence:** Letter received from Brooke requesting non-digital documentation for a Grade 3 social studies project being prepared in Saskatchewan.
